Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1The Trials Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Tanner Cup Rules and Conditions will apply (see Tauranga Yacht and Power Boat Club web site www.yacht.org.nz).
- 1.4 Racing Rules will be changed in accordance with Rule 86 as follows:
 - (a) For Protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
 - (b) Rule 61.1(a) (2) will not apply. Boats intending to protest are required to display a protest flag and shall inform the committee boat at the finishing line of their intention to protest immediately after finishing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The Trials are open to boats of the P Class that comply with the Class Rules. It is recommended that they have a current P Class National Certificate in the name of the current owner.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter on the morning of 23rd November from 8.30am- 9am KYC clubhouse.

- 2.3. To be eligible to compete in this event, each competitor shall be a financial member of a Yacht Club affiliated to the AYBA. Proof of Membership of an AYBA affiliated Club may be requested.
- 2.4. Each competitor shall be under the age of 17 years on January 31st, 2014.

3. Entry Fees

\$30 to be collected at registration on 23rd November, 2013

4. Schedule

Briefing will be at 09.00 hours on Saturday, 23rd November 2013.

Weather permitting; a total of 7 races will be sailed.

On Saturday morning, 23rd November, 2 races will be sailed back to back.

3 more races will be sailed in the afternoon after a lunch break.

On Sunday morning 2 races will be sailed back to back

On both days the warning signal for the first race will be at 1025 hours.

Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after the conclusion of the last race.

6. Venue and Courses

- 6.1. Racing will be conducted on the waters off Kohimarama.
- 6.2. Courses will be triangle, windward/leeward.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 The Low Point Scoring System will be used.
- 8.2 Four (4) Races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3a When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.4b When from five to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Prizes

The Series Winner will be entitled to represent the Auckland at the 2014 New Zealand P Class "Tanner Cup" Inter-Provincial Championships to be held at Tauranga Yacht & Powerboat Club, Tauranga, January 2014. The AYBA will pay the entry fee for the Tanner Cup
