7.	VENUE AND COURSE					
	7.1.	The regatta will be based at Kohimarama Yacht Club.				
	7.2.	The race course will be off Kohimarama Beach. The Harbour Race will be on the Waitemata Harbour.				
8.	MEASU	REMENT				
	8.1.	Boats may be weighed prior to proceeding on the water				
	8.2.	All boats must comply with the class rules at all times during the regatta.				
	8.3.	No equipment that is subject to measurement under 29er class rules may be changed during the regatta without the approval of the Race Committee.				
	8.4.	Wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.				
9.	SCORING					
	9.1.	The high points scoring system shell apply				
	9.2.	Double points will apply for the harbour race				
	9.3.	Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.				
	9.4.	When five races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.				
	9.5.	When from five to eight races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.				
	9.6.	When nine or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.				
10.	SAFETY					
	10.1.	Competitors shall wear a life jacket or other adequate personal buoyancy at all times when afloat.				
	10.2.	Wet suits and dry suits do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.				
11.	LAUNCHING RESTRICTIONS					
	11.1.	Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment must be launched and retrieved from Kohimarama Beach.				
12.	RADIO COMMUNICATION					
	12.1.	Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.				
13.	PRIZES					
	13.1.	The winners of the contest will be the 29er North Island Champions for the season and will receive the 29er Association of New Zealand Trophy.				
14.	PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT					
	14.1.	By entering the Regatta competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the Championship facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitors name or not, without compensation and without the competitors approval of such images or any use thereof.				
15.	TEAM SUPPORT BOATS					
	15.1.	Team and individual support boats will be allowed.				
	15.2.	Team and individual support boats will be allowed. Team and individual support boats and their call sign must be registered with the race committee at KYC.
