# **Notice of Race**

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 2020.
- 1.2. The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. The Tanner Cup Rules and Conditions will apply. Refer http;//www.yacht.org.nz
- 1.4. Under Rule 86, Changes to The Racing Rules the following racing rules will be changed as follows
  - o Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish,
  - Rules A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later that 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.
  - The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.5. Appendix T will apply
- 1.6. P Class yachts will be exempt from displaying a protest flag and shall also inform the committee boat at the finishing line of their intention to protest immediately after finishing. This changes rule 61.1(a).

## 2. IDENTIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The Regatta is open to boats of the P Class that comply with the Class Rules.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form available at www.kyc.org.nz
- 3.3. Late entries may be accepted up until 1700 hours Friday the 6th December 2019, at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 3.4. To be eligible to be able to compete in the event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitors national authority.
- 3.5. To be eligible for selection as an Auckland representative each competitor shall be a bona fide representative as defined in the latest revision of the *Tanner Cup Rules and Conditions*
- 3.6. Each competitor shall be under the age of 17 years on 31st January 2020.

#### 4. CLASSIFICATION

4.1. There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79.

#### 5. FEES

5.1. The entry fee is \$45

#### 6. SCHEDULE

6.1. Registration: Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> of December 2019 from 08:00-08:55, at the Kohimarama Yacht Club The event shall consist of a series of up to 7 races – (refer Schedule below)

- 6.2. Races may be sailed back to back.
- 6.3. Race committee reserves the right to go one ahead in number of races each day in order to ensure a series can be completed.
- 6.4. On Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2019 no warning signal will be made after 1600 hours.

#### 7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. Competitors shall use one hull, one set of foils, one mast, one boom and sail for the entire Championship, all of which shall have been measured and marked at the official measuring. Spot measurement and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the regatta.
- 7.2. Beach trolleys shall be prominently marked with the boats sail number.
- 7.3. All boats must comply with the class rules at all times during the regatta.
- 7.4. Wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.

#### 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> of December 2019 on the notice board at the Kohimarama Yacht Club.

## 9. VENUE

- 9.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 9.2. Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

#### 10. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward and/or Triangle Windward/Leeward.

## 11. PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1. Appendix P will apply

#### 12. SCORING

- 12.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A, Scoring, will apply.
- 12.2. Two races will constitute a series
- 12.3. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.4. When five to seven races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 13. LAUNCHING RESTRICTIONS

13.1. Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment must be launched and retrieved from Kohimarama Beach.

#### 14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

14.1. Except in emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction applies to mobile telephones.

#### 15. PRIZES

15.1. The winner of this contest will be nominated to the Auckland Yachting and Boating Association as the Auckland representative for the 2020 Tanner Cup provided that the competitor complies with Rules 2(b) and 7(d) of the Tanner Cup Rules and Conditions. The number of nominations may be increased in accordance with Rule 2(c) of the Tanner Cup Rules and Conditions.

#### 16. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

By entering the Regatta competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videoed participating in the race and/or using the Championship facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitors name or not, without compensation and without the competitors approval of such images or any use thereof.

#### 17. TEAM SUPPORT BOATS

- 17.1. Team and individual support boats will be allowed.
- 17.2. Team and individual support boats and their call sign must be registered with the race committee at KYC.
- 17.3. Support boats movements will be subject to restrictions that will be specified in the Sailing Instructions

## 18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

18.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.


