Notice of Race

The Organizing Authority for the KYC eSailing Club Championship, hosted on Virtual Regatta - Inshore is, Andy Kensington.

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the [2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing \(RRS\)](#) and Virtual Regatta Inshore App ([Virtual Racing Rules of Sailing](#)). Where discrepancies exist, Virtual Racing Rules of Sailing (those built into the VR App) shall prevail.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 All competitors must be a member of the Kohimarama Yacht Club.

2.2 All participants must create a free account with [Virtual Regatta - Inshore](#).

2.3 Instructions how to join in are in the Appendix A.

2.4 If more than 19 entries are received, the regatta will be broken into pools and subsequent finals. See Event Format.

3 REGISTRATION

3.1 Competitors must be current KYC club members and shall register through KYC Web entry.

3.2 Registration must be completed by Friday, May 8th at 1800 hours.

4 EVENT FORMAT

4.1 There is a maximum of 19 competitors per Series plus the RO. If 19 or less competitors are registered, one Series of 5 races (including one discard) will constitute the regatta.

If more than 19 competitors are registered, the event will be broken into 2 Pools, and have 2 discrete, independently run Series. Initial Pool assignments will be assigned randomly and the top 9 sailors from each Pool Series will move on to a Final Series.

4.2 The Final Series will consist of 20 competitors:

A) The 19 competitors selected from the Pool Series. B) Race Officer (Andy K), who shall run the racing throughout the Regatta.

4.3 The boat sailed in all Series will be the VR – J70

4.4 “Lagging” out due to bad internet connection shall not be grounds for redress.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1 The Regatta shall take place on the afternoon of Sunday, May 10th.

5.2 A full practise series may take place on Saturday, May 9th.

5.3 If less than 20 competitors are registered, one Series of 5 races (including one discard) shall have the first warning at 1300 Hours.

If more than 20 competitors are registered and the regatta is split into multiple stages (see SI 4.1), the Pool A Series shall have a first warning at 1300 Hours, Pool B Series at 1430 Hours, and the Final Series at 1600 Hours.

6 SCORING

6.1 The Low Point Scoring System will be used, along with Appendix A2.

7 PRIZES

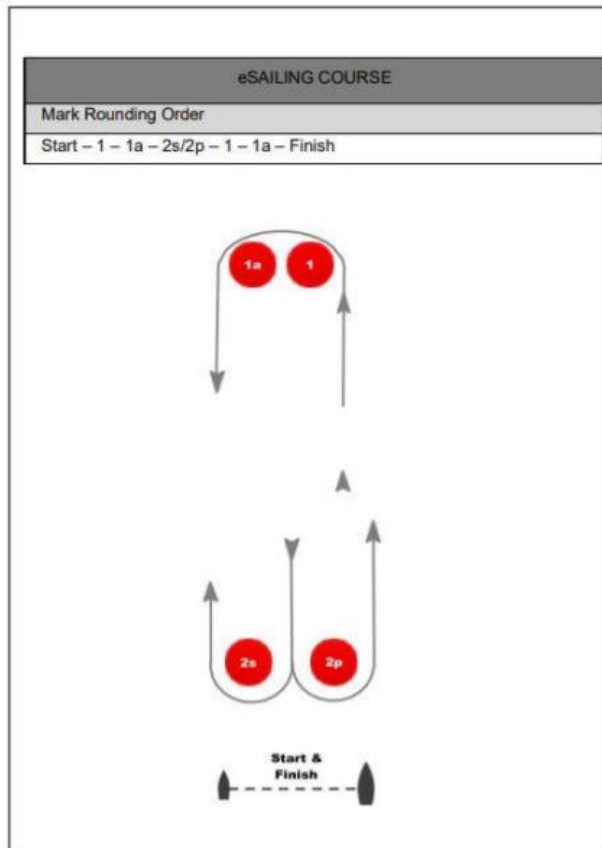
7.1 The winner will be eligible to represent KYC at the [eSailing Regional Championships](#) across the weekend of May 22-24.

8.1 The course will be “Upwind Long” – a windward/leeward course with an offset mark and a downwind finish. TWO laps. See Diagram below.

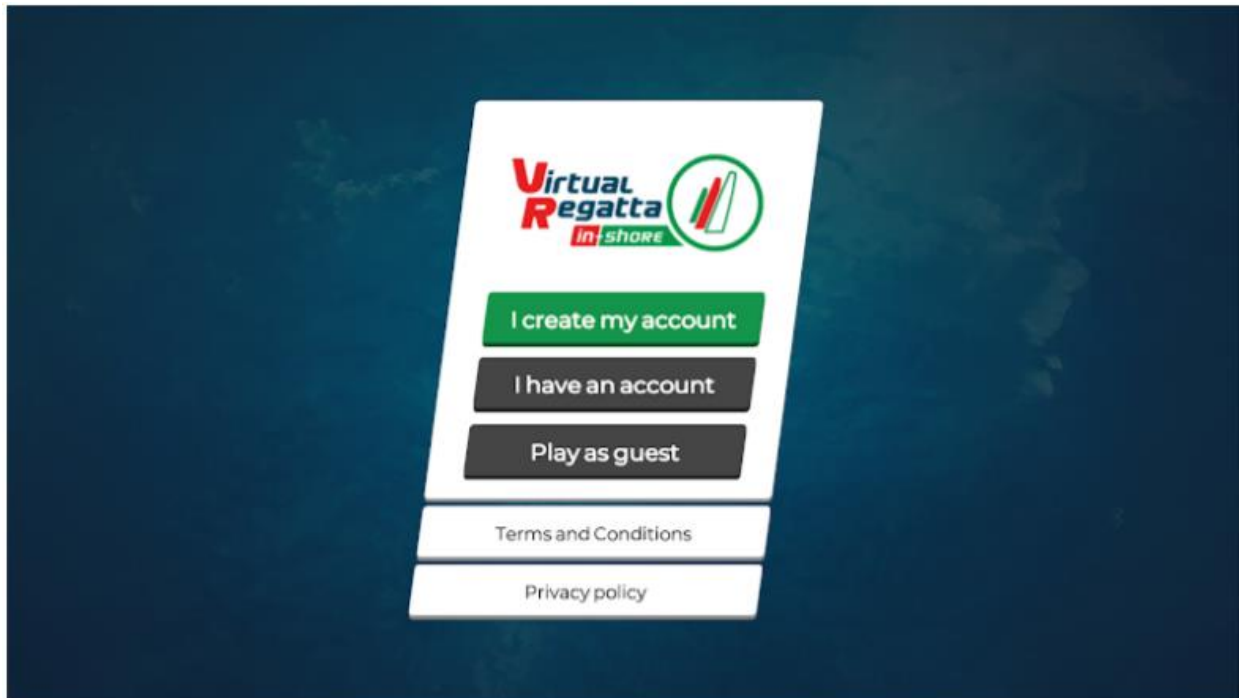

1) Create Account or login

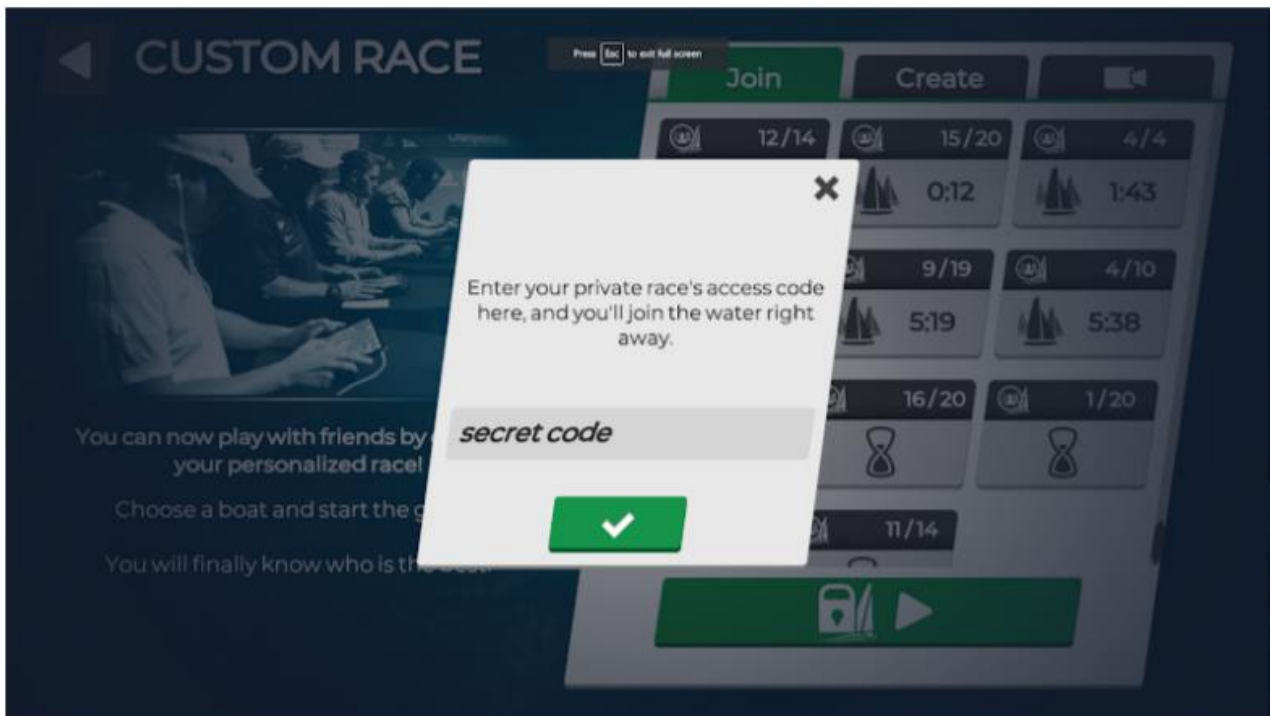
