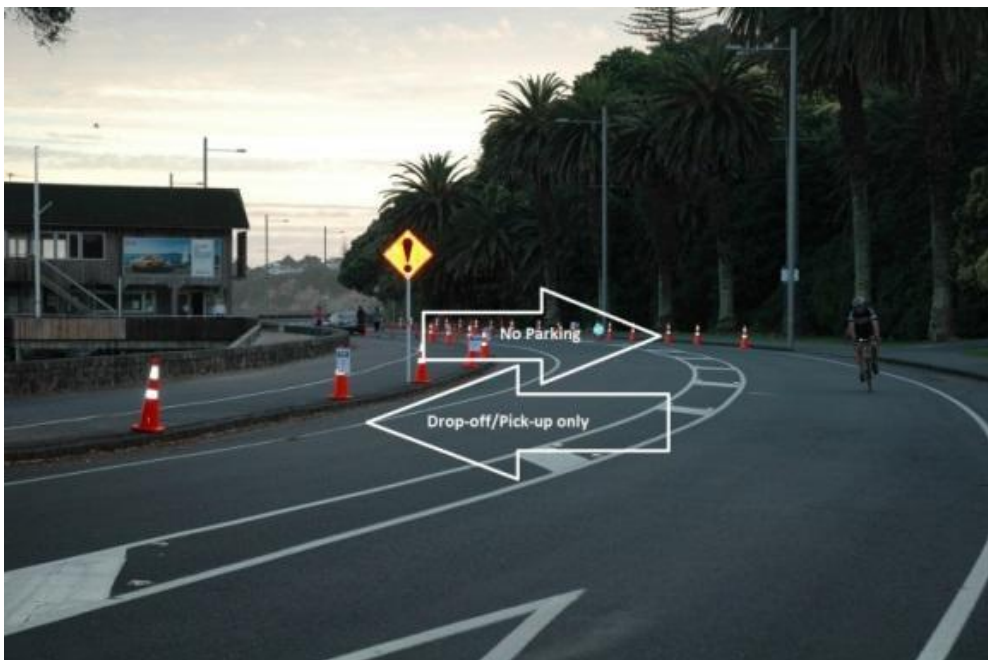




ARRIVING AT KYC FOR JSA 2016

- Please be careful on Tamaki Drive. It is a very busy road (many cyclists on both footpath and road sides), look before opening your car door!
- The seaward side of Tamaki drive adjacent to the KYC clubhouse is for drop-off and pick-up only - 10 minute maximum (see picture below)
- Friday afternoon and Saturday morning KYC will have helpers to assist you to quickly unload boats and gear. Once unloaded you will be asked to drive off to find longer term parking.
- There is no parking opposite the club adjacent to the grass area (see picture below)
- There will be limited parking for road trailers on the grass area opposite the KYC clubhouse.
- Parking is available on the streets surrounding Kohimarama and St Heliers. Please be considerate of our neighbours. There will be tow vehicles about and expect a ticket for “inconsiderate parking” if you infringe a driveway
- Note the Clearway signs for the Friday on the seaward side of Tamaki Drive to the east of the KYC yacht club.



Competitors Yacht Storage

- All yachts are to be stored on the sand beach for the duration of the regatta.
- No boats are to be stored on the grass reserve.
- Security for boats will be present Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday nights.
- Please ensure all trailers are clearly labelled with sail numbers (+ green ribbon for green fleet).



Support Boat & Trailer Parking

- We would prefer all support boats to be delivered on Friday afternoon/evening.
- There will be a tractor available to park your boat on the Kohimarama Beach adjacent to the boat ramp.
- Security will be present Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the boat ramp.
- Please drive forwards off Tamaki drive (do not reverse onto the boat ramp).
- KYC Boat ramp team will help unhitch your trailer and the tractor will park your boat.
- Three point turn, and carefully drive out onto Tamaki drive.
- **Clearly label boats, trailers and totes to aid us in locating correct boat/trailers etc. on launching and retrieving.**
