

2018 NZ P Class Inter-Provincial Championship for the Tauranga Cup

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 - 2020.
- 1.2. The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. The Tauranga Cup Rules and Conditions will apply. Refer - <http://www.yacht.org.nz>
- 1.4. Under Rule 86, Changes to The Racing Rules the following racing rules will be changed as follows
 - o Rules 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish,
 - o Rules A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.
 - o The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.5. Appendix T will apply

2. IDENTIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The Regatta is open to boats of the P Class that comply with the Class Rules and have a current P Class National Certificate in the name of the current owner and have been nominated by a Representative Body as defined in the P Class Rules (includes Tauranga Cup Rules and Conditions).
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form available at www.kyc.org.nz by 23rd December 2017.
- 3.3. Late entries may be accepted up until 1700 hours Friday the 5th January 2018, at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 3.4. To be eligible to be able to compete in the event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitors national authority.
- 3.5. Each competitor shall be under the age of 17 years on 31st January 2018.
- 3.6. The following documents must be provided at registration;
 - I. Proof of yacht club membership,
 - II. Proof of current P Class registration,
 - III. Copy of competitor's birth certificate.

4. CLASSIFICATION

- 4.1. There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79.

5. FEES

- 5.1. Required Tauranga Cup fee is \$175

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Registration: Sunday 7th of January 2018 from 1200 to 1600, at the Kohimarama Yacht Club
6.2. Equipment inspection and event measurement: Sunday 7th January 2018 from 1200 to 1600, at the Kohimarama Yacht Club

The event shall consist of a series of up to 10 races – (refer Schedule below)

- 6.3. Races may be sailed back to back.
6.4. Race committee reserves the right to go one ahead in number of races each day in order to ensure a series can be completed.
6.5. On Wednesday 10th January 2018 no warning signal will be made after 1400 hours.
6.6. Prize Giving will be held on Wednesday the 10th January 2018 in conjunction with the Tanner Cup Prize Giving (after racing).

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. Each boat shall be presented to the regatta measurer for measurement and inspection
7.2. Competitors shall use one hull, one set of foils, one mast, one boom and sail for the entire Championship, all of which shall have been measured and marked at the official measuring. In addition, spot measurement and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the regatta.
7.3. Beach trolleys shall be prominently marked with the boats sail number.
7.4. All boats must comply with the class rules at all times during the regatta.
7.5. Wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Sunday 7th of January 2018 and on the notice board at the Kohimarama Yacht Club.

9. VENUE

- 9.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
9.2. Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

10. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward and/or Triangle Windward/Leeward.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1. Appendix P will apply

12. SCORING

- 12.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A, *Scoring*, will apply.
- 12.2. Five races will constitute a series
- 12.3. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.4. When five to eight races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.5. When nine or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

13. LAUNCHING RESTRICTIONS

- 13.1. Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment must be launched and retrieved from Kohimarama Beach.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 14.1. Except in emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction applies to mobile telephones.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - Tauranga Cup – Highest ranking sailor from the overall results,
 - Memorial Cup – Second place in the overall results,
 - Carter Cup – Third place in the overall results,
 - Naomi James Challenge Trophy – Highest Placed Female Sailor from overall results,
 - Harken Trophy – Second Placed Female Sailor,
 - Harry Highet Salver – Winner of the Invitation/Practice race,
 - Murrays Bay Cup – Highest Placed first time competitor
 - Farr and Associates Trophy – Youngest competitor in top ten overall results
 - Franklin Plumbing Trophy – Club of Tauranga Cup Winner
 - The Colin Smith Trophy – Highest Placed Sailor from host Club
 - The Craig Monk Trophy – Highest place getter over 55 kg
- 15.2. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority or the New Zealand P Class association

16. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

- 16.1. By entering the Regatta competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videoed participating in the race and/or using the Championship facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitors name or not, without compensation and without the competitors approval of such images or any use thereof.

17. TEAM SUPPORT BOATS

- 17.1. Team and individual support boats will be allowed.
- 17.2. Team and individual support boats and their call sign must be registered with the race committee at KYC.
- 17.3. Support boats movements will be subject to restrictions that will be specified in the Sailing Instructions

18. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 18.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

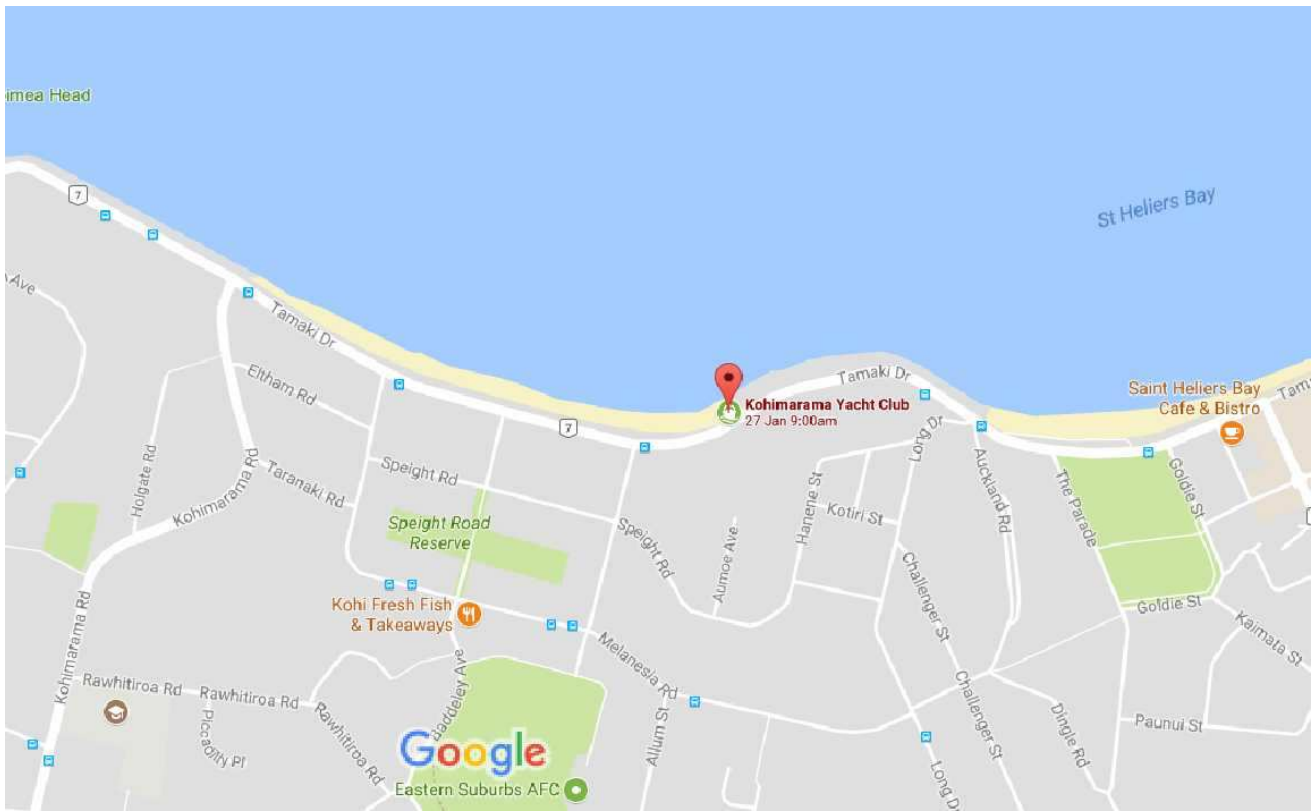
