NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3** Racing Rule 61.1(a) will be changed to state that "A competitor intending to protest is required to inform the race committee at the finish line of their intention to protest immediately after finishing"
The change will appear in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.4** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.
- 1.5** Appendix P shall apply as amended in the Sailing Instructions

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Starling Class that comply with the Starling Class constitution and class rules.
- 3.2** All competitors shall be current financial members of the Starling Class Association (SCA).



- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online form and together with required entry fee at www.kyc.org.nz by Wednesday 20 January 2021.
- 3.4 Late entries will be accepted up until and including Friday the 22 January with the payment of the required late entry fee
- 3.5 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

Proof of affiliated club membership may be requested.

- 3.6 The Development Fleet is to encourage less experienced and less confident Starling sailors to sail and participate at major Starling regattas. To be eligible to race in the Development Fleet a competitor shall not have previously raced in Open Fleet except where no Development Fleet was offered.

4 CLASSIFICATION

There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Required fees are as follows:

Starling Development Fleet	\$80
Late Entry Fee (In addition to normal entry fee)	\$45

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration will be held from 800 hrs to 930 hrs on the Saturday 23 January 2021.
- 6.2 The intention is to hold a sailor briefing at 0930 hrs at the Kohimarama Yacht Club. This may change depending on the Covid-19 Alert Level and restrictions/guidelines in place at the time.



6.3 Dates of racing:

Date	Warning Signal	No of Races Scheduled
23 January 2021	1030 hrs	4
24 January 2021	1000 hrs	3

6.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs

7 MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Each boat shall be registered on the Starling Class Association measurement list.
- 7.2 No formal measuring will take place except that a boat may be inspected for compliance with the class rules at any time.
- 7.3 Each boat shall comply with Yachting NZ safety regulations Part 1. In particular this includes a rudder/tiller lock, a towing eye or fairlead, a centreboard lanyard, a suitable bailer tied on, the sail number written on the side of the hull in figures 50 mm high.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no later than 800hrs on the 23 January 2021 on the Notice Board at the Kohimarama Yacht Club and online at www.kyc.org.nz.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Appendix A shows the location of the regatta venue
- 9.2 Appendix B shows the approximate location of the racing area.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Trapezoid or Windward/Leeward.



11 SCORING

11.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2

- a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When four or more races have been completed to boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall register with the organising authority prior to first warning signal. [DP]

13 LAUNCHING

All Starlings shall be launched from Kohimarama Beach. All beach trolleys shall be clearly marked with sail number of the boat. [DP]

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

15 PRIZES

The North Island Championship trophy shall be awarded to the highest ranked Youth Sailor.

Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.



17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

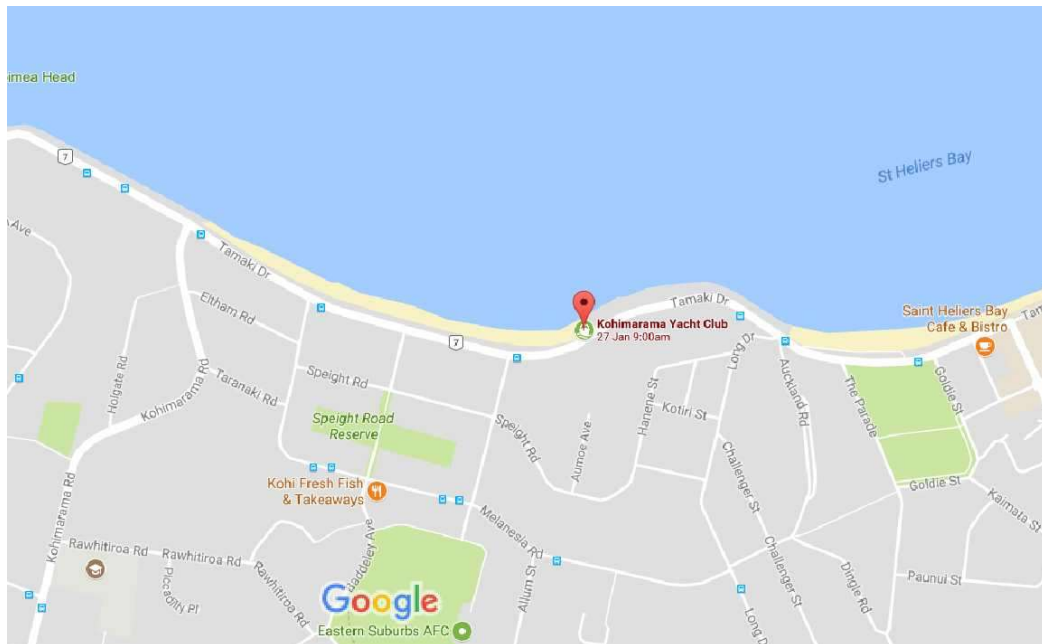
