Stay informed:

We encourage you to sign up for our Stack Team App – **KYC Junior Sail Auckland 2025**. This app will be used as our primary form of communication during the regatta. If you haven't already downloaded and registered to Stack Team App you will need to do this before finding the right team to join.

Simply log-in and search for KYC Junior Sail Auckland 2025, then request to become a member.

Storage and Launching

Overnight security will be provided at the KYC clubhouse and support boat ramp on Friday 16th and Saturday 17th. You are encouraged to drop your boat on Friday and leave over the weekend.

All boats must be launched and retrieved from Kohi beach. To assist our security team, please park boats on the sand close to the club rather than spread down the beach to assist our security team. No boats can be stored or rigged on the deck of the clubhouse.

Please make sure your beach trolley is clearly marked with the boat's sail number.



Traffic Management

Tamaki Drive is a very busy thoroughfare, especially on weekends. We have put in place a traffic management plan, and we ask that you take note of the below map, which indicates no-parking areas.

Please do not move any traffic cones – these cones are in place for the safety of everyone attending an event at Kohi Yacht Club.



Sign on/off

All sailors will need to sign on before heading out on the water and off when they come off the water. This is a mandatory safety protocol to ensure all registered sailors are kept safe.

Support Boats:

Importantly, you will need to register your support boat on our website via this link: <u>SUPPORT BOAT REGISTRATION</u>. Support boats can be left overnight on the sand either side of the boat ramp as we will have security on site overnight.

Support boats can be launched at the public boat ramp halfway down Kohimarama beach.

PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE ON THE SAND (its likely to get stuck!) We have a tractor to assist launching for registered boats on Friday evening (between 6pm – 7pm), Saturday and Sunday.

What's on offer:

Good news - our infamous Bacon & Egg baps are back on the menu and will be available for sale Saturday and Sunday from 8.30am.

And finally:

- Please bring:
 - Sunscreen
 - Refillable Water Bottle
- Supporters on shore please help launch and retrieve the sailors even if they are not your own child as their parent might be on the water volunteering.
- Keep the ramp clear
- No boats should be stored or rigged on the clubhouse deck keep this area for sailors and supporters
- Label your sailing gear clothes, boat covers, foil covers etc
- And (again) make sure your beach trolley has your sail number on it
